

Kateryna Lysovenko

(born 1989) is a Ukrainian artist. She works in monumental painting, painting, drawing and text. Kateryna is engaged in the study of the relationship between ideology and painting, as well as production of the image of the victim in politics and art. In her work she is engaging traditions and inspirations ranging from antiquity to the present day. Lysovenko regards painting as a language that can be instrumentalized or liberated.

Since Russian full scale invasion on Ukraine, her works have become one of the most recognized images of the Ukrainian voice and perspective. But her historical and artistic reflection has a wider, universal and humanistic angle.

She lives and works in Vienna, Austria.
